2. Santos Can, who we met at our Bellaire Christmas event. He is a believer who continues to go to church. Please pray that God will continue to strengthen his faith.


## 12/7/2013 AT BELLAIRE

**Andrew's Report:** I arrived at the Bellaire location at 7:45 AM and was surprised to find that a couple members of *Kris' small group* were present already. I helped them to set up the tables and pack the bag lunches that we would pass out to the workers later that day. *David Wang, Paco*, and two brother from Paco's church named *Carlos*

*Carlos Guzman* and *Alfredo Madrigales* also arrived at the event.

We began with a word of prayer. Then the children of *Kris' small group* played "Joy to the World" and "Amazing Grace." *Carlos Guzman*, one of the brothers from *Paco's church*, played and sang a couple more songs in Spanish. Then *Paco* preached his message to 36 workers. We finished by handing out the bagged lunches, gifts (through a drawing), and clothes. We ended with a closing prayer at around 10:00 AM.



**Kris' Report:** It was a very cold and windy morning, but all volunteers showed up bright and early, very excited for this event. Most of the brothers and sisters from the Agape group arrived about 8 AM, some even earlier to get ready for the event.

Unlike last year, when more than 20 workers were already waiting at the event site when we arrived; there was virtually no one waiting this time. We had passed out more invitation cards this year, but I looked around and saw very few workers even standing around. I started to concern about the turn out for this event.

I invited Brother Jonathan to walk around the area to gather the workers as the rest of the coworkers continue to set up for the event. I was shocked to see how few workers were even outside that morning. I had never seen the area being so bare before. Last Saturday, there were more than 30 people standing by the fence behind Home Depot at this exact same time, but there was only one person that day. Only one! My heart sunk. But immediately I heard Brother Johnathan say to me: "let us pray." Yes, at that moment, praying was the only thing we could do and should do. We prayed together as we walked around the area, all the way back to our event site. My heart was at peace then, because I knew God would provide. We had done everything in our power to plan for the event, and it was time for God to take over and use this event to further His kingdom. And He did.

We had 24 adults and 12 children volunteers at this event and we prepared more than 70 meals and presents as well as plenty of clothing. We were ready and started with a prayer together at around 8:20 AM. Seven of our children brought their music instruments and performed "O Come All Ye Faithful" and "Amazing Grace" while the adults sang the good news to these workers. Despite the bitter cold, the strings digging into the fingers of these children; they performed beautifully and never complained. The music brought much warmth to the heart of our Hispanic friends.

Brother Carlos Guzman sang a few Spanish songs after this and Paco started his sermon. It was a very special day. Through the tears of repentance and the laughter of joy, we experienced God in our midst and witness the work of the Holy Spirit. When all the brothers and sisters come together to serve the Lord and show our love and care to our neighbors, we are the ones who receive the most blessings. May God continue to bless our hearts and continue to allow us to be a part of His plan and His will.








## 12/28/2013 SHARING EVENT AT WEST BELLFORT
