A special day for a special ministry event. What we lacked in only having a small number of migrant brothers we gained in a moving event where the Holy Spirit stirred passions to call out to Christ for help and the blessings they seek.

Some of our migrant brothers seemed especially moved because they have come to trust and befriend many of us in the HIMN ministry. A blessing in itself. They opened up about their deep concerns of an increasing immigration presence and efforts to find consistent work in a spotty economy. They prayed and asked for prayers having to do with being reunited with family and loved ones, to find basic health care, to find a steady work source and for other day to day needs.

Some migrant brothers thanked us for being a ray of hope and for HIMN sharing scripture, they pointed out this spiritual guidance and immersion in scripture occurs few and far between. Several requested and were given Spanish language bibles. There are other local ministries, a nearby Korean church for example, that bring food and drink but are unable to share the gospel as this caring local Korean ministry lacks a Spanish speaking staff or pastor.

Many brothers were moved to step forward and ask for blessings for help and hope in their daily struggles to maintain a "normal" life.

Please continue to pray for and lift up our local, Houston migrant brothers and sisters in their struggles to remain hopeful in Christ..
