1/12/2013 SHARING EVENT AT BELLAIRE

Around 18 to 20 workers listened. Sister Lucy Zhang gave tracks to many workers around the place; She brought the food and the drinks for the workers and she helped to serve too. We finished praying together.

We began with a word of prayer and we began our work. Since we did not have any volunteers who could speak Spanish, we simply passed out tracts and bottled water to every worker we saw. Lucy spoke some Spanish and so said "God loves you" in Spanish to the workers. She courageously crossed the street to reach many of the workers who stood on the other side of the street where we were passing out tracts. I had never before seen a HIMN volunteer do so before. We went to all the known locations where we know we could find them. We ended at around 10:05 AM with a word of prayer.

Mrs. Wanchan's Report:

Today we, including myself, Andrew and Lucy, went to West Park location. We prepared 122 water bottles and spiritual tracks. We distributed water bottles and spiritual tracks from the end of HW59 to Chimney Rock along Westpark Dr. Lucy knew some Spanish and led the team to distribute water and spiritual tracks. Lucy has come to sharing event almost every week now. She was earnest to distribute the tracks and water bottles. She always ran before us and crossed the street without any fear. She caught every "fish" she could see. She didn't let anyone to go by without getting spiritual tracks and water bottles. She was determined and courageous to share faith with people. I was thrilled to see God put some passion of fire in her heart already. She was just baptized recently. I met her in my cell group. She also knew some Spanish. All the spiritual tracks were gone. All the bottles except 10 bottles were gone. We reached more than 110 people. Only 2 workers refused to accept our spiritual tracks. We are happy to see many of them read the spiritual tracks. Hallelujah!!!

1/26/2013 SHARING EVENT AT WOODRIDGE

Paco's Report

We started around 9:05 am, showed up *Dan Zhuang*, Lucy's husband, *Manuel Mendez*, *Arturo Mendez* from Grace Church and *me*. We started praying together then we gave tracks to the workers and invite them to the event. I preached about 2 Kings 4: 1-7; where one wife needed to pay the debts that her husband left when he died.
