I wanted to take some pictures to document the event but noticed some of the workers looking at me so I did not for fear of distracting them from the sermon. The workers listened intently, and most seemed unwilling to leave the gathering when a white pickup arrived with a work offer. It seemed that they only went to the truck when Paco told them it was all right (I do not know exactly what was said because I do not speak fluent Spanish). When Paul returned with the water, we handed them out to the workers and when Paco finished preaching and ended his sermon in prayer, we handed out the tracks to them. We ended our time together with prayer and we all went home.

Paco also reported,

Sharing event 8/25/12 Bellaire and Beltway 8; We started at 9:30 am, and Andrew Wang and Paul Huang showed up. Paul brought the drinks. We parked close to the workers and around 15 persons listened me. I spoke to them about Genesis 2:9,16, and 17; Where God made all kinds of trees in Eden, but he made 2 special in the middle of the garden, The tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. I showed them if Adam ate from the tree of life, He had the life of God in him for ever because the fruit of the tree is Jesus; but Adam decided to eat from the tree of the Knowledge of good and evil, that's the reason they take their own decisions whether it's good or bad for them, they don't care what God says; They act in their own mind what is good for their life and what is bad and the consequences of their bad decisions is that they will die; Ephesians 2:1, You are dead in your transgressions and sins; What is the solution? ..
