He challenged the workers to not only focus on the hard work of this world, but also be workers for God and our faithful God will reward them handsomely. We then passed out donuts and juice to all the worker around us.

While Pastor Santiago was delivering his sermon, The Holy Spirit prompted me to continue to pray for Pastor Santiago, for the workers, and that for nobody to drive by to hire these worker to disrupt the message until the sermon ends. Sure enough, the was not a single car come by to hire the workers until right after the sermon ended. God is faithful!

At first, only 11 of the about 24 workers in the area gathered to hear the sermon; but because of Pastor's Santiago powerful voice, more workers were attracted to the sermon. At the end, there were about 16 workers listening to the sermon. Pastor Santiago invited the workers to accept Jesus Christ as their personal savior and 6 workers responded by raising their hands. Halleluia, God is faithful, God is wonderful!

While the event was going on, brother Alfredo was witnessing one-on-one with a worker at the other side of the parking lot. He had started to talk to him while passing out the tracts, and continued to witness to this worker throughout the entire sharing event. At the end, he told us that worker also accepted Jesus Christ as his personal savior.

We had a great event because the presence of the Holy Spirit was clearly with us. Praise Him, our awesome God! May God continue to use us and reward & bless us for the work that he wants us to do for Him.
