Andrew informed us that we were to assist the ministry of another church that day. We chat with the 2 brothers and observed how they conduct their ministry; but was not able to provide any physical help to them. Lucy passed tracts and water to several workers across the street.

Andrew brought some tools as additional incentive to attract the workers, but due to the way we and the other church conducted the event, there was no opportunity to give them out in an effective way.

We then moved to our second location under highway 59 and passed out more tracts and water to about 15 people.

Andrew led us in closing prayer around 9:30AM and we ended the event.

### 3/18/2013 SHARING EVENT AT WOODRIDGE

Paco's Report:

*Dan Zhang* from Fort Bent Community Church showed up. He brought bottles of water and I from South Houston Bible Chapel, brought the tracks. We started around 9:10 am and we finished around 10:40 am. We preached to 15 people and we gave bottles of water and tracks around 50 workers.

I spoke with some special worker who didn't want to listen nothing about the Bible, but then he understood we don't talk about any religion. We talked about life and how one day we will be in front of God by ourselves. Just you, your sins, and God's holiness! What should you say to Him? And we planted the seed in his heart! 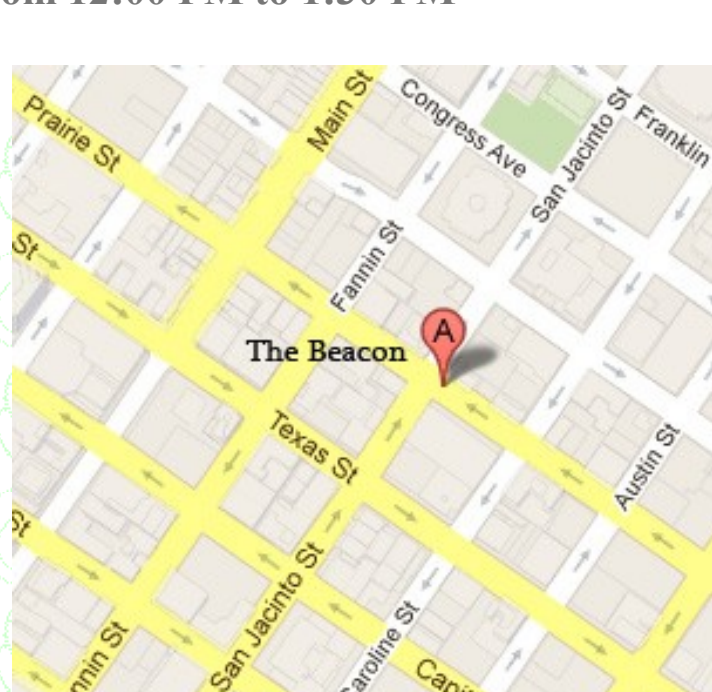
